\* In Alaska and Delaware, 65 on some interstates; In Arkansas, 65 on some limited access roads; In Idaho, 80 for passenger vehicles and 70 for trucks on some roads; In Kentucky, Illinois, and Pennsylvania, 70 on some roads; In New Hampshire, 70 on some roads; In Oregon, 70 for cars and 65 for trucks on some roads; In Michigan, 75 on some roads; In Texas, 80 or 85 on some roads; In Utah, 80 on some roads; In Washington, 75 on specified roadways; In Wyoming, 80 on some roads.

<sup>2</sup> In Oklahoma, DOT may increase the speed limit beyond 75 mph on any highway or part of a highway based on an engineering and traffic investigation.
